1. McClure Bacon Fest Beverage Garden is a rain or shine event from 11am to 5pm. Please plan accordingly.
2. Beverage Garden set up begins at 9am on the day of the event. You may set up early if you wish. Please contact us for earlier setup.
3. For set up, proceed to the rear of the Post Office and use the southwest corner of the lot to unload your vehicle.
4. Space is limited in the Post Office Parking Lot. Please unload your vehicle and then move it to the designated vendor parking area before setting up your booth. There is **absolutely no parking in the Post Office Parking Lot.**
5. No vehicles are permitted back in the festival until after 5:30pm. You **MUST** be packed and ready to load before you retrieve your vehicle.
6. Vendors must park in the designated vendor parking area (about two blocks away). Please do not park on the side streets of the Borough. If you have a mobility issue and require to be parked close to your booth, please let us know so we may try to accommodate.
7. All canopies must be securely weighed down with at least 15lbs at each leg. (Sand bags, cinder blocks, water filled buckets, etc.)
8. The McClure Revitalization Committee does not provide or rent tables, chairs, or canopies.
9. All tables must have a drape/covering/tablecloth. Floor length coverings are preferred.
10. Beverage vendors supply their own cups.
11. Beer/Wine/Spirits vendors serving at the event in the designated beer garden do not have a set up fee.
 - a. \$1 drink tickets will be sold by the McClure Revitalization Committee.
 - b. Beverage vendors will set their own price per drink and only tickets may be used for payment.
 - c. Beverage vendors are not permitted to accept cash or cards for beverages consumed in the garden.
 - d. Tickets are turned in to the McClure Revitalization Committee at 5pm at the end of the event.
 - e. A check will be issued for the total amount of tickets minus a 20% commission collected by the McClure Revitalization Committee.
12. Beer/Wine/Spirits vendors are expected to follow all rules and regulations set forth by the PA Liquor Control Board (PLCB), PA Dept of Health and PA Dept of Agriculture regulations.
13. You must provide a copy of your insurance certificate listing McClure Revitalization Committee, Inc. **AND** Borough of McClure as additional insured for the day of the event.
14. Booth sizes are 10'x10'. Stay within your designated space. Do not set up displays in front of or behind your booth.
15. Beverage vendors may opt to also set up a booth on the street for bottle sales. This requires submission of a Craft/Food Vendor application with the appropriate booth fees.
16. All vendors must remain open until the end of the event. Any vendor packing or leaving before 5pm may not be invited to return.
17. Use of McClure Bacon Fest name and logo on your products for sale is strictly prohibited.
